Directions for the Torg Brewery Lift





The difference between a "Lift" and an "Elevator" is primarily in the way they operate from the inside. A lift requires that you hold down the button until you have reached the floor of your destination. An elevator just has the need for one press of the button. The lift at Torg brewery was already part of the building when they purchased and offered a great way for people with wheelchairs, or those unable to climb the stairs to get to the second floor. But it's a **Lift**, not an elevator.

- When entering the lift, press the button of the floor you want to go to and hold it down until the lift comes to a stop.
- If you temporarily take your finger off the button and the lift stops, simply
 press it again until you arrive at your destination.
- If you happen to press the emergency button the lift will stop and will not operate until you clear the emergency. You will know if the button is engaged as the lights will flash on both 1 and 2.
- To clear the emergency situation and start toward your destination—Pull the emergency stop button out and twist it. You will know the emergency is cleared when the lights stop flashing on both 1 and 2.
- Re-engage toward the floor you want to stop at.

If you accidentally trip the emergency button on the way up—enjoy an extra beer. If it happens on the way down—think about having someone else bring you home
